American Payroll Association 2021 Payroll Education Grants

The Payroll Education Grants were established by the American Payroll Association in 1992 to honor its founder and first president, the late Donald W. Sharper, CPP. The grants are designed to encourage professional growth through APA's payroll training and educational offerings.

These grants are presented each year to **six** outstanding members of the Association in recognition of their professional and personal commitment to continuing education. The six grants include:

- **One**

Complete APA Payroll Education Package entitling the recipient to the following:

- (1) Registration to Congress Xstream
- (2) Registration for any or all APA seminars for one year, beginning with the Congress Xstream and including courses at the Payroll Learning Centers in San Antonio, TX, or Las Vegas, NV (not including travel or hotel expenses)
- (3) A complete library of current APA books and publications, plus *PayTrain*®

- **Two**

APA Course/Conference Grants entitling two recipients to a free registration for any one APA course or conference of their choice. This grant is good for one year, from May 18, 2021 through May 19, 2022. The free registrations do not include travel or hotel accommodations.

- **Three**

One-year subscriptions to *Payroll Source Plus*®, APA's online payroll reference library that includes *The Payroll Source*®, *Federal Payroll Tax Laws & Regulations*, *Federal Payroll Non-Tax Laws & Regulations*, *APA's Guide to State Payroll Laws*, and the *PayState Update* newsletter

Wisely Pay by ADP 2021 Payroll Education Grants

Wisely Pay by ADP established its two grants to help payroll professionals by providing opportunities for education. Candidate Requirements

- (1) Current member in good standing of the American Payroll Association.
- (2) Minimum of three years of work experience in the payroll field.
- (3) Previous grant winners are not eligible to apply for another award until at least three years after receipt of their previous award.

How to Apply

To complete the online application, log in to www.americanpayroll.org/members/edgrant. You may complete the application for yourself or nominate a fellow APA member. Please provide the applicant's contact details, including name, email address, and best contact telephone number. Points will be awarded for the completion of each item as indicated below:

- (1) Educational advancement
 - A. Professional growth, certifications, etc. (maximum 5 points)
 - B. Education (maximum 10 points)
- (2) Two letters of recommendation, signed and in PDF format, detailing why the applicant is a worthy candidate for an education grant. Please ensure the letter is no older than two years old. (maximum 5 points each)
- (3) A list and brief description of applicant's accomplishments, documenting:
 - A. Involvement in process improvements within the applicant's job, department, or organization (i.e., cost savings, efficiency/productivity increases, etc.) (maximum 15 points)
 - B. Organizational growth (i.e., staff development, corporate awareness, etc.) (maximum 5 points)
 - C. Participation in community service (i.e., civic engagement, volunteer work, etc.) (maximum 10 points)
 - D. Involvement with the American Payroll Association for the past three years
 - Local and/or State/Regional level (maximum 10 points)
 - National level (maximum 10 points)
- (4) Personal statement. Describe how receiving an education grant would help the applicant in the advancement of his or her payroll professional career. Limit the response to one typed page of 50-100 words. (maximum 25 points)

NOTE: APA employees, as well as members of the APA Board of Directors and Officers, Board of Advisors, and National Speakers Bureau, are not eligible for these grants, but they may nominate someone.
